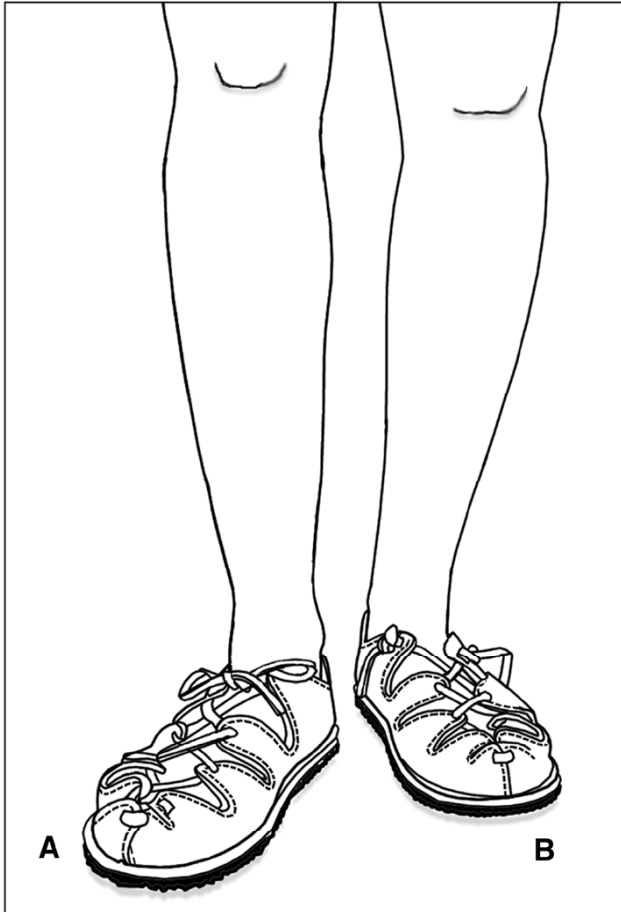


LACING INSTRUCTIONS FOR GHILLIES

Thank you for purchasing our hand-made Celtic Ghillies. They may seem short at first, this is normal. After you have set the heel, you will gain length. Wiggle back into the heel. Let your body heat begin the Nativearth customizing process.

To care for your Ghillies leather, select oils or creams you would put on your skin. With occasional cleaning and nourishing, your ghillies will give you many years of pleasure.

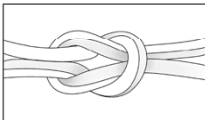


A: FRONT TIE

Laces are pulled forward and tied into a bow.

B: Lace cut short and knotted on each side, as a slip-on style.

Square Knot

C: Celtic lacing up the leg.

Always end with a square knot.

D: Roman style ankle lacing.

The square knot may end in front or back.
